Dear Parents/Guardians,

After careful consideration, as a result of the increase in pool hire charged by the IW Council the Club's committee have taken the decision to increase the cost of our swimming lessons with effect from 1 September 2015 as follows:-

30 Minutes lessons - £33 per block

45 minute lessons - £38 per block

In order to ease the pressure on our volunteers we are also requesting that **all payments** to the club are made electronically rather than by cash or cheque, using the swimmers **first initial and surname** as our reference. Our bank account details are as follows:

Please ensure all payments are made prior to the first lesson in each block and each child will be automatically renewed for the next block of lessons unless you say otherwise. If you have any particular problems with paying electronically please let us know.

As of September 2015 swimmers, parents and guardians may notice our volunteers in new kit. The committee has decided that to tie in with the new season our swimmers will compete in the name of Seaclose Swimming Club, Isle of Wight only at competitions, rather than the current amalgamation of both The Isle of Wight Swim Team and Seaclose SC. In order to make that change we have adopted a new logo and team kit. For those interested, kit will be available in both adult and children's sizes and details of how to place an order will be placed on the clubs website. We would also encourage any parents/guardians of swimmers to visit the Club's website which hosts lots of information including our Club Code of Conduct for Swimmers, Parents/Guardians, and Volunteers and our Welfare Statement.

The future of our club relies on the continued support of volunteers and as always we are looking out for more volunteers to come forward. In particular we are currently looking for volunteer lifeguards, and teachers. You do not need any qualifications as we will fund the training for the right candidates, all we ask is that you dedicate some time, usually over a minimum period of one year in return.
